1. KICK-OFF MEETING (23 AND 24 /03/06 IN BESANÇON)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

On March, 23rd and 24th 2006, the caENTI kick-off meeting took place in Besançon. The caENTI consortium participants and Mrs Andrea SCHMOLZER, Scientific Officer of the caENTI consortium, participated to this meeting.

Claude CONDÉ, President of the Université de Franche-Comté (UFC), welcomed the participants and expressed the satisfaction of the Université de Franche-Comté for the project excellent evaluation. After having recorded the University support, he wished the exchanges developed between the caENTI consortium partners and particularly a European master is implemented on the basis of the scientific and Professional competences gathered within the caENTI.

2. WP5 SCIENTIFIC COORDINATION MEETING (05/05/06 IN HUELVA)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

The first meeting of WP5 Governance took place in Huelva (Spain) on May, 5th 2006.

During this seminar, the six European universities and the two Spanish actors members of caENTI met. During the caENTI first year, this group was in charge of the elaboration of an experiences catalogue of on its members own action-research activities.

Blanca MIEDES UGARTE, WP5 leader, welcomed the participants on behalf of the Rector of the University of Huelva.

Jean Jacques GIRARDOT, coordinator of the caENTI, presented a conference on the CAENTI main objectives and their activities.

Then, Blanca MIEDES UGARTE and Dolores REDONDO TORONJO presented two communications, the first one concerned the WP5 programming and the second one presented a guide for the study of the action-research experiences.

The debate allowed the group:

- Remembering the multidimensional character of the issue they had to deal with.
- Thinking about the research-action concept.

In order to draw limits able to help the researchers in charge of the experiences catalogues, the group decided to focus its analysis on the action-research projects that have the following characteristics:

- Elaboration of rough drafts of 6 catalogues (20-30 page length, 2-3 pages by experience) by the July, 10th.

- The information and the common synthesis finalization by their delivery date, that is December 2006.

Mihai Pascaru presented the International Conference of Alba Iulia from September, 21st to 23rd 2006.

The meeting allowed starting up the CooSpace use. Thus, Peter ACS presented the guide of use and the key-elements of this virtual platform of cooperative work. The WP5 CooSpace scene will be a tool to cooperate in the catalogues and the synthesis drafting, and also to draw the conclusions from the gathered information.

3. WP6 SCIENTIFIC COORDINATION MEETING (29 AND 30/06/06 IN DURBUY)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

During the scientific coordination meeting of DURBUY that took place on June 29th and 30th 2006, the **WP6** members met for the first time. There were about 25 people, as there were also some WP4 members. This scientific coordinaton seminar aimed to create cross activities at the territorial indicators level.

Celia SANCHEZ LOPEZ introduced a first version of the European guide to be debated.

Cyril MASSELOT presented a first proposal of services repertory prototype.

Jean-Jacques GIRARDOT suggested principles to choose the contextual indicators. A link was established with the WP4I about territorial information that is animated by the University of Liège. On the following day, the WP4I meeting established the principle to jointly work on the choice of twenty indicators, in order to compare the guide important questions.

During the meeting of Durbuy, the caENTI consortium also started drafting the Catalyse guidance notes. Celia SANCHEZ LOPEZ presented a communication about the contents definition that will be followed by a specific forum on COOSPACE.

The WP6 started following the experimentation of the ACCEM "migrants" guide.

Jean-Jacques GIRARDOT and Maria José ASENSIO COTO introduced the aspects linked to the Catalyse participative uses within partnerships. The WP6G agreed on the idea each territorial actor will draft an history of tools use and some recommendations.

On June, 30th 2008, The WP4I group presented the first results about the territorial information inventory made on the basis of European statistic bases and sites and of national websites of European. Then, the meeting participants debated the first suggestion of themes and indicators presented by Di CHEN. The participants decided together which themes and indicators would be chosen. Another document was distributed to the participants: it shown if there is or not the lower spatial level of the suggested indicators in 10 European countries national Internet site. However, Jean-Jacques GIRADOT decided not to take into account of these data in a first stage, as we could built the missing data later by ourselves. The chosen themes were people, socio-economic conditions, employment and housing.

The WP4P also presented the first identification of research projects made by using a first series of key-words. This selection proved itself to be too selective. As regards the projects identification, the coordination group debated about the opportunity to widen the canvassing field to all the funding, beyond the research activity and the key-words used to identify projects. The debate insisted on the complexity to identify action projects funded by the European Union.

4. WP4 AND WP6 SCIENTIFIC COORDINATION MEETING (04 AND 05/07/06 IN AIX-EN-PROVENCE)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

For practical reasons, the meeting was organised both for the WP4T territory and the WP6E school members.

The meeting detailed the central question of WP4T: “From « when », that is to say from which type and which level of « organization », a natural or human « space » becomes a

« territory », *that is to say from when the process of « site specification » is developing?*”. The group chose a first series of themes :

- Rural school organization facing demography evolutions, Territorial actors and competences sharing
- The school territorial base
- Forms of school organization, recruitment areas
- Territorialization of educational and vocational offer
- Problematic issues and methodology questions

This scientific coordination meeting allowed the WP6e (Rural School Observatory) defining its objectives, its work phases and its preliminary issues. Besides, this working group debated on the feasibility study of the European Elementary School Observatory, on the basis of the French experiment. The group objective would lead research activities on the Information about school itineraries of the elementary school pupils, analyse the links between school and community in a local sustainable development prospect and focus on the educational inequalities linked to territory. In addition to these three objectives, it also decided to work on a caENTI transversal objective: the study of the tools appropriation by local actors.

The Observatory of European School feasibility study phases will be: mobilisation, feasibility and integration.

During this scientific coordination meeting, several preliminary questions were identified:

1. Which school should be observed?
 - Which age class (from 6 to 16 year old)?
 - Which status: only the audience of the public sector schools, but perhaps also the activities that take place during the pupils spare time and the private schools?
2. How to define the itineraries?
 - Which criteria should we privilege? urban / rural, public / private, European scale
 - Which indicators of school success? (difficulty to compare very varied school systems)
 - Which territory indicators: zoning, etc.
3. Regarding feasibility, the following tasks are planned:
 - Adaptation of the Catalyse tool
 - Possibility to create local teams
 - Team training and supervision

6. WP5 SCIENTIFIC COORDINATION MEETING (18 AND 19/01/07 IN LIÈGE)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

It was planned in 2007 the work of each research group would be revised and debated by a group composed of three people (one representing the actors and two representing two different research groups). The intended goal was to get a deeper debate on the principles, objectives and methods of each research group, on the basis of the catalogues written in 2006.

This work final objective is to identify the best practices and the main characteristics the research-action processes should present so as to be useful tools for the decision-making of the actors' and the partnerships networks they are involved in.

The session was open with a brief presentation of the work programme by the WP5 leader. Then, there was a presentation by Mihai PASCARU about some Rumanian experiences linked to territorial intelligence, governance and research-action.

Afterwards, in order to define the starting point of the work the group should deal with, each university made a presentation of the main conclusions of its final experiences catalogue and the WP5 leader presented a synthesis of all the catalogues contents.

Lastly, we debated the WP5 work programming during year 2007, and in this prospect we agreed on the creation of seven work-groups:

8. WP5 SCIENTIFIC COORDINATION MEETING (13 AND 14/04/07 IN MADRID

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

This meeting aimed to coordinate the drafting of the Quality Letter proposal.

This meeting starting point was the principles we have yet agreed on in Liège: Multidimensionality, Partnership, Participation, Transformation, Sustainability, Transparency, Co-responsibility and Co-learning.

The work made by the group in Madrid consisted in:

1. Completing the principles list and in defining them in a more precise way.
2. Analysing the main implications of their application in real research-action projects (including the possible adverse effects) on:
 - Research-action topics to be selected
 - Methodologies: main characteristics
 - Pursued Results: social and scientific pursued impact.
 - Use, diffusion and transfer of the got results.
3. Actors and researchers role in the research-action processes (relations and responsibilities).

As the implementation of these principles is very complex, we wanted to specify the methods and research-action protocols that can favour its application.

This debate results led to the elements required to draft the European Quality Letter of research-action favouring the territorial governance of sustainable development.

Each of the participants to the meeting of Madrid made a brief presentation summing up its ideas regarding the three points evoked above. This presentation objective was addressed to generate a brainstorming session. That is why each team included in its presentation the elements it considers more interesting or more necessary to be included in the Quality Letter.

The main aspects debated in these sessions were:

- The research-action principles:

Regarding the principles they were definitively enunciated as follows:

1. Transformation: it is an implicit principle in the research-action concept; it consists in fostering the transformer role research can perform on social reality. Social needs constitute the starting point.
 2. Multidimensionality: focusing on the research object by using a multidimensional and multisectorial well-balanced approach.
 3. Partnership: fostering and involving territorial partnerships in the research-action processes.
 4. Participation: guaranteeing the territorial actors' that directly face territorial issues participation is carried out in an effective way.
 5. Sustainability: it consists in carrying out long-term research processes which are required to obtain a more evolutionary knowledge in order to generate sustainable territorial development dynamics.
 6. Transparency: the research-action processes must lead to a higher transparency of the results regarding both knowledge and policies, by facilitating and democratizing the decisions making processes.
 7. Co-responsibility: the “action” component and the “research” processes are equally responsible for the process evolution.
 8. Co-learning: the research-action processes must facilitate the cooperative learning of all the participants, improving the the territorial system bility to look for solutions to the future problems whilst keeping in mind their past experience. In other words, they ought to strengthen the territorial intelligence development.
- Concept of a “Quality Letter”: The group also agreed on drafting the Quality Letter by the means of the writing of a common principles set of principles inspiring “better practices” to foster territorial governance of research-action. The objective is this letter become a reference document for the researchers and actors involved in the action-research processes linked to territorial development.

10. WP5 SCIENTIFIC COORDINATION MEETING (28 AND 29/09/07 IN HUELVA)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

This scientific coordination meeting that was not initially planned was finally organized by taking advantage of the scientific meeting organised in Huelva at that period to review the last preparation tasks to be made regarding the caENTI Second International Conference that was supposed to take place in October 2007.

Four universities and two territorial actors attended this meeting. They debated made suggestions concerning to the proposal of Action-Research Quality Letter draft to be presented during the international conference of territorial intelligence of Huelva.

We agreed on the following aspects regarding the final version structure of the Quality Letter:

- Elements to be included in the context (aims, theoretical bases, political implications)

Description of the method (How has it been established? Which was the validation process?)

- Definition of quality
- Inclusion of some guidelines: rules and recommendations, instructions, directions, suggestions, pieces of advice; regulations, principles, guiding principles; standards, criteria; procedures...

The definition of quality was debated much, but eventually a great consensus arose on the following concept:

The quality of an Action-Research process depends on its capacity of enhancing:

11. FIFTH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF TERRITORIAL INTELLIGENCE (24-27/10/07 IN HUELVA)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

The International Conference of Territorial Intelligence of Huelva « Territorial intelligence and governance. Participative research-action applied to Territorial Development » took place from October, 24th to 26th 2007.

The Conference main objective, apart from intensifying the cooperation between the network members, was to debate with other members of the scientific community and other

territorial actors interested in issues linked to territories sustainable development, territorial intelligence, territorial governance and the link between all these concepts. This conference orientation is based on the idea the actual and long-term participation of researchers and territorial actors is the key-element to understand territorial dynamics and to look for solutions to the main territories problems.

On this basis, the three suggested reflection and debate themes are:

- A. Participation research-action applied to territorial sustainable development;
- B. Application of participative research-action methods and tools to territorial sustainable development;
- C. Analysis of the experiences of research-action applied to diagnosis, management and evaluation of territorial projects.

The conference was mainly organized by Universidad de HUELVA, it received 130 participants coming from 11 countries, and 50 communications written by 104 authors were presented at this occasion.

October, 24th started with a meeting of the Steering Committee that make decisions about the caENTI main work orientations until the project end. Then, the meetings specific to the different Work Packages allowed finishing the research activities programming until February 2009.

On October, 25th, the activities started with two invited conferences, the first of them « the worldwide governance challenges » was presented by Professor Carlos Berzosa, Rector of the Universidad Complutense of Madrid and President of the Worldwide Economy Society. The second conference was presented by Professor Tomás Rodríguez Villasante, an expert recognized at the international scale in the field of participative methodologies applied to development. The afternoon was devoted to the debate on the caENTI scientific results until during the first eighteen months of caENTI and to the presentation of the workplan to be implemented until the action end. The day finished with the presentation of the Quality letter of Territorial research-action written by the caENTI actors and researchers within the Work Package 5 framework.

October, 26th morning was devoted to the presentation of the communications presented by the participants in six workshops. During the afternoon, two plenary sessions allowed debating other key-issues linked to the conference thematic. One was general: the link between university and territorial actors within the framework of research-action projects; it was animated by Manuela De Paz, Professor of the Universidad de and Director of the Observatorio Local de Empleo (Local Employment Observatory). The other debate was more specific: it concerned the ethical and organizational issues generated by the new technologies use to process information in research-action projects. This debate was animated by Doctor Cyril Masselot of the Université de Franche-Comté, a researcher who has much experience in this field.

17. SIXTH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF TERRITORIAL INTELLIGENCE (15-18/10/08 IN BESANCON)

1. Meeting objectives and synthesis

The sixth International Conference of Territorial Intelligence mobilised 248 participants of 22 nationalities, and among the 218 European participants there were 124 French people. 29 researchers were from North and South America, Asia and Africa. Organised within the caENTI Framework the conference gathered 123 researchers and actors members of the caENTI, but also 115 other researchers and actors.

The conference general theme was “Tools and methods of Territorial Intelligence”

The call for papers, published on January, 31st 2008, suggested three themes:

- A. [Tools] – The tools of territorial intelligence for and by actors of sustainable development (coordination: Jean-Jacques GIRARDOT)
- B. [Methods] – The scientific methods and the generic tools of spatial observation and of territorial information analysis (coordination: Serge ORMAUX)

C. [Concept] – The evolution of the territorial intelligence concept (coordination: Philippe DUMAS).

This scientific event organised by the Institute of Humanities, Social and Environmental sciences of the Université de Franche-Comté was very successful. The scientific committee reviewed and selected 148 communications over 182 proposals.

The WP2 worked with the WP3 -which manages the software ConfTool- to make registrations and communications proposals reviewing. The WP3 also edited a blog concerning the conference. PhD students in geography, students in master of digital edition and in master of applied languages participated to its feeding with real time articles on the conferences and workshops, videos and pictures. Besides, the Université d'Alba Iulia assisted the UFC with the blog by working on the line video cover, in order to be able to publish in real time the workpackages contents and reports.

83 of the papers presented during the international conference of territorial intelligence of Besançon were published in the caENTI deliverable 16.
