"1 Decembrie 1918" University of Alba Iulia (UAB) has contributed to the caENTI Project especially with the organisation of major events, the annual conferences: • UAB has organized the first caENTI Conference in 2006, in Alba Iulia. UAB collaborated with the organizing universities in preparing the conferences in Huelva (2007) and Besancon (2008).



Through its experts, UAB has contributed to the online caENTI broadcasting. Besides, the Alba Iulia and Huelva conferences proceedings were printed by the UAB book house; • Concerning the work team involved in the project, UAB especially contributed to the WP4 and Wp5.



UAB also contributed to the dissemination of the caENTI results and to the creation of connections with other projects funded by the Romanian Ministry of Education, Research and Youth in the field of territorial intelligence and using the Catalyse methodology.



UAB disseminated the caENTI results within territorial actors (representatives of development agencies, of county councils, mayors and public servants) who were invited to present papers and attend the debates of the caENTI Conferences: • Dissemination in the local and regional mass-media. Journalists were invited to attend the Conference in Alba Iulia; • Attendance of conferences organized in Romania; • Attendance of prestigious international events (The European Rural Sociology Congress, Wageningen, the Netherlands, 2007).
